A leather shoe making social business to enhance the capacity of individuals with disabilities

THE SOCIAL PROBLEM

- Majority of adults with disabilities remain unemployed despite their desire to contribute to the workforce.
- They often face social stigma from employers and/or coworkers.
- They face lack of opportunities for education and training.
- Lack of disable friendly working environment is another setback.

THE SUSTAINABLE SOLUTION

Create a leather-shoe producing social business to train and employ people with disabilities.

PRESENT STATUS

Action on Disability and Development (ADD International), a human rights organization working to promote the rights of people with disabilities in Bangladesh for last 20 years has initiated a project to train and employ disabled workers to produce quality leather shoes and sandals.

Presently 25 disabled workers are producing 2000 pairs of shoes and sandals per month. Presently they are being informally sold through different organizations that promote wellbeing of disabled people.

ADD wishes to convert their current project into a Social Business. Legally it will be operating as a separate company formed under the Companies Act ;1994.

Business Plan

Method: Use local raw materials to produce leather shoes and sandals. **Workers:** Employ previously unemployed men and women with disabilities.
